# Pain Management ICD-10-CM Coding

### ICD-10-CM CODE G89-

There are extensive guidelines for reporting pain codes in category **G89**, including sequencing rules and when to report a code from category **G89** as an additional code. It should be noted that pain not specified as acute or chronic, postthoracotomy, postprocedural, or neoplasm-related is **not reported** with a code from category G89

## **Reason for admission**

Pain control	Principal Diagnosis-G89, then code site/underlying condition
Other reason, not pain control. Definitive cause of pain unknown	Principal Diagnosis - Pain site, then assign G89
Insertion of neurostimulator for pain control	Principal Diagnosis- G89, then code underlying condition
Treatment of underlying condition	Principal Diagnosis - Underlying condition. Do not assign G89
Treatment of pain related to	List code F45.42, then G89- Circumstances of admission decide the sequencing

**Note**: Coding postoperative pain is based on the provider's documentation. Routine or expected postoperative pain immediately after a surgery is not coded.

There is no time frame when acute pain becomes chronic. Query provider

## **NEOPLASM RELATED PAIN MANAGEMENT**

- If visit is for pain management, assign *G89- and then neoplasm code*
- If visit is for treatment of neoplasm and pain during the visit-assign Neoplasm, then G89-

#### POSTOPERATIVE PAIN MANAGEMENT

If pain is associated with Post op complication, assign *complication code, then G89*-if pain is not related to post op complication, then G89.18/G89.28

Central pain syndrome: G89.0

Chronic pain syndrome: G89.4
